

*The 86th annual Lake Odessa Fair Grand Parade will be held June 23, 2021 @ 6pm. Judging will take place at the village park, Swifty's Place, before the parade as well as through the duration of the parade. All entrants must be in full costume at least 1 hour before parade time. All entrants able to proceed into the fairgrounds will be asked to do so and continue through the grounds past the pickleball courts and proceed down the lane adjacent to the courts and end on the southeast end of the fairgrounds. Assembly time is 5:00-5:30pm. All floats must be created within the last 12 months. Classes offered are listed below.*

- 1) *Amateur (floats created by non-professionals and entered by any community organization or individual, civic or service club.)*
- 2) *Miniature Children's Floats*
- 3) *Individuals (clowns, animal costumes, etc.)*
- 4) *Bicycles (decorated)*
- 5) *Antique Cars*
- 6) *Harness & Horse Drawn Vehicles (costume class)*
- 7) *Individual Horses (costume class)*
- 8) *Commercial Floats (industrial, business, state agencies or commission, created by professionals or non-professionals) - Certificate to be awarded*
- 9) *Tractors*

*Judging will be based on participants costume or float appearance as well as performance during the parade. The decision of the judges is final and will be announced within a half hour of the parade conclusion at the fair office. No motorcycles, mini-bikes or motor-driven two, three or four wheel vehicles unless pre-approved. No entry fee. NO RAIN DATE  
WILL BE SCHEDULED.*
